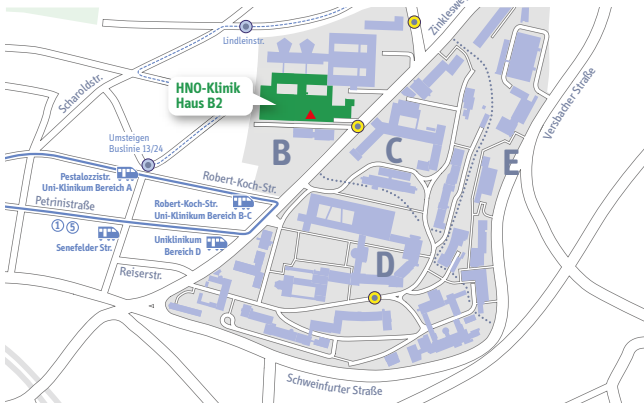

Distinguished speakers will present works on the state of the art and new developments, covering a broad spectrum of topics in smell and taste diagnostics, treatment, and research.



### Practical courses

During the practical courses we will focus on the following:

- ▶ investigations of trigeminal sensitivity
- ▶ nasal endoscopy and intranasal volumetry
- ▶ anatomy of the „olfactory brain“
- ▶ histology of the olfactory epithelium
- ▶ MRI-based volumetry of the olfactory bulb
- ▶ biopsies from the olfactory epithelium
